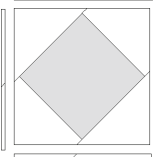


Pieced Border – Throw Size

- 33) Square up the resulting square to 6½". [Take care to leave a ¼" seam allowance at the side points of the inside square.]

Throw	Twin	Full	Queen	King
5	8	13	14	17

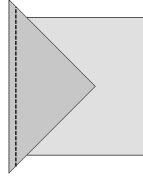
Make Diamond Centers

- 34) Cut the number of 6" Background squares indicated by your size of quilt across BOTH diagonals dissecting each into 4 triangles.

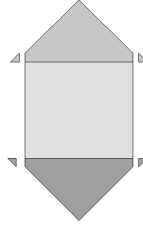


# of Scrappy 6" Squares to Cross-cut				
Throw	Twin	Full	Queen	King
4	7	12	11	8

- 35) Using a ¼" seam allowance, attach one of the Background triangles (cut above) centered along one edge of a Scrappy 4 ¾" square. Repeat, attaching another Background triangle to the opposite side of the Scrappy square. [Take care to not sew two like colors beside each other to enhance the "Scrappy" look.]



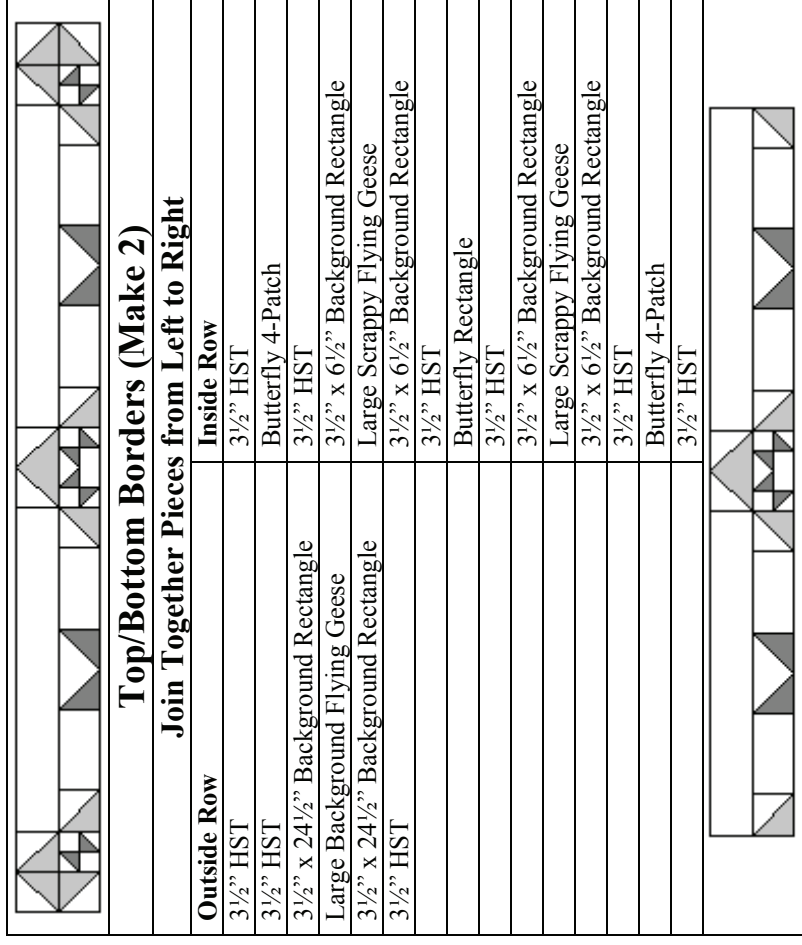
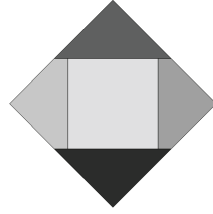
- 36) Press the seams towards the triangles and trim off the excess at the corners.



- 37) Center and attach two more Background triangles to the remaining two sides of the Scrappy square.



- 38) Press the final two triangles towards the triangles.
